Dan Boothe is currently studying composition and conducting at Radford University with world-renowned band composer, Mark Camphouse. Mr. Boothe is a 1996 graduate of Wicomico High School and is also an alumnus of West Virginia University where he studied music education and composition. He has served on adjudication panels throughout the United States including the WGI World Championship percussion panel and the Southern California Percussion Alliance Championships. As a performer he maintains a well rounded career with freelance work in Baltimore, Washington, and Pittsburgh and as a sub for the Roanoke Symphony Orchestra. Most recently he earned 8th place at the P.A.S. World Snare Drumming Championships.

Dan Boothe has been recognized as a Maryland Distinguished Scholar and is a University of North Texas Cham Uswachoke Percussion Scholarship recipient. He has received additional performance scholarships from West Virginia University, Radford University, Ithaca College of Music, and the University of Maryland .

He is a member of the Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, the Percussive Arts Society, and has a membership with the American Society for Composers, Authors, and Publishers pending.

Coronation and Fanfare is dedicated to James M. Anno and was composed for the Wicomico High School Symphonic Band under his direction. The opening motif and subsequent development convey the magnificence of this man’s accomplishments and the nobility of his character. As the fanfare begins near the end of the piece, it signifies the beginning of something new while celebrating the past with a gold flare. James Anno has been director of the Wicomico High School band for twenty-five years. During this time the band has achieved a reputation for excellence on the marching field and the concert stage, having won eight major marching championships, including the Maryland State Championship in 1990, and twenty three Superior Ratings at the annual District Band Festival. Mr. Anno credits this success to the many hundreds of dedicated student musicians who have been members of the band during this time.

Mr. Anno is a graduate of Old Dominion University and completed his graduate studies at Catholic University, University of Maryland, Peabody Conservatory, and West Chester University. He is a recipient of the MMEA “Award For Excellence in Teaching”. He was a member of the Army Band in Virginia and taught in Calvert County, MD before coming to Wi Hi. He is a member of Phi Mu Alpha Sinfonia, The Music Educators National Conference, Maryland Music Education Association, Maryland Band Directors Association, and the Eastern Shore Band Directors Association. Mr. Anno will retire at the end of this school year.

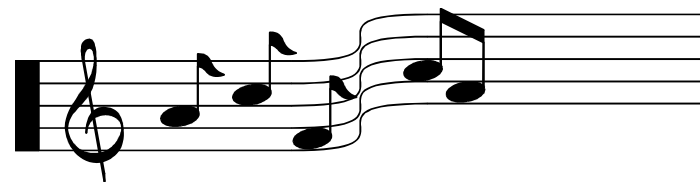
